

Foundation Skills for Your Future

Personalised Training in Language, Literacy, Numeracy and Digital Literacy

The Australian Government announced a new national program as an initiative under the 2019-20 Budget to support eligible Australians with a means to develop their Language, Literacy, Numeracy and Digital Literacy (LLND) skills to help them up-skill or re-skill for new work roles.

The program aims to assist participants to obtain, or retain, secure employment, and to undertake further education and training through fully subsidised training delivered in standard Registered Training Organisation (RTO) settings or in the workplace.

Participants must:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- have left secondary school education
- be aged 15 and over, and
- be employed or recently unemployed (within nine months) and not registered with an Australian Government employment service provider

Participants will **not** be eligible if they are:

- a full-time student; or
- enrolled, or eligible to be enrolled, in the Australian Government's Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) or the Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) Program; or
- enrolled, or eligible to be enrolled in, existing state and territory subsidised or partially subsidised language, literacy, numeracy and/or digital skills training programs

Training

Training is bespoke and will be delivered through a personalised, client-centred approach and be aimed at levels up to a Certificate II. Delivery can be flexible according to client need and run at times and for a duration to suit participants. Participants will be assessed initially to identify skills gaps and an individualised training plan will be mapped to areas for development.

Personalised training focuses on four key skills:

- English, oral and written communications skills
- Numeracy (practical maths skills to use in everyday life)
- Reading skills
- Digital skills
